**Memorandum of Understanding**

The areas of collaboration, cooperation and association shall include organisation of livelihood training, capacity building training, exchange of resource persons, student exposure and related other issues. The primary objectives of this MoU are to facilitate students as well as faculty members of the college and NGO workers to experience social work at a broader platform by sharing knowledge and working together. Further, the MoU will also benefit the students as well as faculty members of the college and NGO workers of both the college and the NGO through mutual access to resources.

The MoU is signed by **Dr. Birinchi Choudhury**, Principal, Barbhag College and **Mr. Tapan Baishya**, Secretary, Lotus Progressive Centre.

(a) The MoU will encourage the following cooperative activities, in particular:

1. Policy dialogue to regularly exchange information and experience on education as well social challenges and to identify priorities for bilateral cooperation in the field of education, awareness, livelihood, capacity building and social mobilization.
2. Exchange and professional development of officials, resource persons, experts, students, faculty and NGO workers.
3. Organisation of joint conferences, awareness, livelihood training, capacity building training, exhibitions and symposia on matters of mutual interest. Moreover the parties agree to work together for developing a system for new innovations in agriculture technology, organic farming, preparation of biomanure, preparation of biopesticide and will take initiatives for creation with transfer of knowledge.
4. Arrangement of requisite infrastructure for above mentioned activities as per need of the college and the organisation.
5. Arrangement of Student exposure program, student internship program of the college or exposure program of social training groups of the NGO whereby both the parties could be benefited by having access to learning resources in each other's institutions.

(b) 1. The cost of cooperative activities may be funded as mutually determined. All cooperative activities under this MoU will be subject to the availability of funds of the college and the NGO. However as the NGO has limited financial resources, the college agrees to provide all expenses for necessary arrangement like venue, participants, resource persons, sound system and refreshment of participants etc. for all the activities to be done at college venue.


2. This MoU may be amended by mutual written consent of the college and the NGO.


3. This MoU will remain in effect for an initial period of 5 (five) years and may be extended, on mutual consent, for successive periods spanning not less than one year.

4. The MoU may be terminated by mutual agreement of both the college and the NGO. However, under no circumstances, termination can take place less than one year after it is signed.
