Today on 23/01/2018 an awareness programme on Self employment and Entrapreneuership is organized by the Career Guidance Cell of Barbhag College in collaboration with IQAC(Internal Quality Assurance Cell). The programme begins with the honorary felicitation of Dr Nandita Goswami, Assistant Professor, Economics department, Barbhag college with a Phulan Gamusa. The programme is presided by honorable Mr Phanidhar Deka, Principal-in-charge of Barbhag College. The speech by Dr Nandita Goswami started with the addressing of the students in the auditorium hall. In her speech she addressed the issue of unemployment in India, and how, self employment and entrepreneurship can to some extent solve loopholes in the employment issues of India. She continues with the explanation on skills playing a major part in self employment providing tailoring, pottery and other crafts as an example. Furthermore, she also speaks of Freelancing, which is one particular form of self-employment, where one could earn by engaging themselves with projects and works for different companies. She in her speech, talks about the need of the growth of rural industries including the village and cottage industries. She also suggested the student's different means of self employment and entrepreneurship that could be undertaken by them. The production of local traditional Assamese jewelleryes, mekhela chador, japi and other products, to cater to the needs of consumer according to their tastes and choices could also undertaken and have given utmost importance to the revival of local handicrafts and pursuance of the same as entrepreneurship and self employment options. At the end, and interaction session with the participants held , where she conversed with the students about their idea of different options they might pursue and are available. They also discussed about the pros and cons of opening their own businesses. At the end after addressing their doubts, the programme ended with a vote of thanks by Mr Ajit Sharma, Associate professor of English department, Barbhag College, who is also a member of the career guidance cell. Around 40 students attended the programme, making the programme a successful one.
