




Academic Session-2017-18

As the affiliating college of Gauhati University, Barbhag College follows the rules and regulation and the curriculum designed for the undergraduate Programme under the University. The Department of Education of Barbhag College always tries to ensure that the syllabus is completed in a fruitful manner within the stipulated time in order to enhance and to improve the teaching-learning process of the Department. And for this purpose, the Department of Education, every year, conducts a process of feedback analysis on the curriculum and action is taken thereafter on the basis of the received feedbacks from the students of the Department. The department follows a specific feedback system. Students' feedback on the curriculum is taken through a specific questionnaire designed to bring out students' outlook towards the curriculum and also distributed the same among the students.

In the academic session 2021-22 a total of 103 students were enrolled in the major courses in the Department of Education. For the feedback, 60% of the total enrolled students that is 62(31 boys and 31 girls) students were selected. To receive feedback a questionnaire was prepared by the faculties of the department regarding various aspects of the syllabus and its transaction. Then the questionnaire was distributed among the randomly selected sample students with arequest to fill-up it. However, Personal information was not collected through the questionnaire as it may affect the feedback and overall result. After the final semester results the feedback was collected from the students and discussed in the departmental meetings. Based on the resolutions taken in the departmental meetings, actions were taken to resolve the drawbacks.




Figure: 1 Graphical representation of the students' feedback on different attributes of the Syllabus

After analyzing the feedback given on the curriculum by the students, the following point of concern can be observed:

- 1. Almost 90% of the students expressed that the syllabus is covered within the stipulated time.
- 2. Among the students, 78% of students are satisfied with the distribution of content across the papers.
- 3. Almost 86% of the students find that the college library has sufficient relevant materials.




Figure: 1 Graphical representation of the students' feedback on different attributes of the Syllabus


Details of Analysis of Feedback



As the affiliating college of Gauhati University, Barbhag College follows the rules and regulation and the curriculum designed for the undergraduate Programme under the University. The Department of Political Science of Barbhag College always tries to ensure that the syllabus is completed in a fruitful manner within the stipulated time in order to enhance and to improve the teaching-learning process of the Department. And for this purpose, the Department of Political Science, every year, conducts a process of feedback analysis on the curriculum and action is taken thereafter on the basis of the received feedbacks from the students of the Department. The department follows a specific feedback system. Students' feedback on the curriculum is taken through a specific questionnaire designed to bring out students' outlook towards the curriculum and also distributed the same among the students.

During the academic session 0f 2017-2018, a total number of 26 students are enrolled in the final semester class of B.A. (Major) course under the department. Taking 60% of the enrolled students i.e. 16 students are included in the study and feedback forms on the syllabus and its transaction are distributed offline among these 16 students. After the response of the final semester students, the feedback forms are collected and are discussed thoroughly in the department meetings. On the basis of the resolution taken in the departmental meeting, actions are taken for improving the curriculum.

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


Table 1: Graphical Representation of Students Feedback on the Syllabus and Its Transition, 2017-2018

Feedback Analysis Result, 2017-2018

After analyzing the feedback given on the curriculum by the students, the following point of concern can be observed:

- 1. Almost 90% of the students expressed that the syllabus is covered within the stipulated time.
- 2. Among the students, 65% of students are satisfied over the distribution of contents across the papers; while 35% are not satisfied with the distribution of content across the papers.
- 3. Almost 95% of the students find that the college library has sufficient relevant materials.
- 4. 86% of the students think that the syllabus is designed according to the students' understanding power.
- 5. 94% of the students are satisfied with the teaching-learning process conducted in the institution.
- 6. Among the students, 79% are satisfied with the assessment process of the curriculum.
- 7. 83% of the students show satisfaction over the opportunity to participate in students-exchange Programme.
- 8. 87% of the students believe that the paper-wise credit system can serve the desired goals of imparting education.
- 9. 93% of students are satisfied with the syllabus.



Action-Taken Report, 2017-2018

On the basis of the feedback analysis, the following actions are taken to come over the issues related to curriculum:

- 1. On the basis of the feedback, the Department of Political Science has informed the Governing Body of Barbhag College through I.Q.A.C. over the dissatisfaction of 35% of students, so that the issue can be communicated to the affiliated University.
- 2. The Department is satisfied with the feedback of 90% of students where they expressed that the syllabus is completed within time. However, the department keeping in mind the dissatisfaction of few students, the department has decided to take extra classes and remedial classes.
- 3. Students also expressed their concern over the delay in the announcement of results. But the department has very limited power in the announcement of examination results. However, the department has requested the Governing Body of the college to convey this issue to Gauhati University.
- 4. The students of the Department are satisfied with the opportunity provided to the students by the Department to organize teacher-students exchange and to participate in field study. In the academic session 2017-2018, the department along with the department of Political Science of P.B. Anchalik College organized a teacher-students exchange Programme.
- 5. The students, in the feedback, showed satisfaction over the teaching-learning process conducted in the department. To improve this, the Governing Body resolved to introduce ICT enabled classrooms. To engage students in the teaching-learning process, the department decided to regularly conduct class seminar among students.
- 6. The department decided to raise a demand to modify the syllabus of Political Science in the undergraduate Programme of Gauhati University. It will enrich the contents including the current issues of political science.
- 7. The department of Political Science also demanded in the meeting of the academic council where it put demanded in front of the Governing Body to release funds to purchase books for the department.



After the response of the final semester students, the feedback forms are collected and are discussed thoroughly in the department meetings. On the basis of the resolution taken in the departmental meeting, actions are taken for improving the curriculum and the teaching-learning process.


