Guiding Principles

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) prepares strategy and planning on various aspects in line with the Vision and Mission Statements of the College, and also in order to fine-tune the academic and administrative requirements of the College. The Co-ordinator, IQAC places the policy making proposals in the IQAC core committee meetings, resolutions adopted and the same are forwarded to the College Authority for discussion and appropriate resolutions in the Governing Body. As per direction of the College Governing Body (G.B.), the Principal/Secretary of the College implements and executes them through a process of decentralization of works.

The present Perspective Plan has been prepared for a period of five years, from July 2017- June 2022 so as to set up quality benchmarks in Academic as well as Administrative matters.

Objectives of the Perspective Plan

ANNUAL STRATEGIC PLAN, 2021-2022

The Governing Body of Barbhag College adopted annual strategic plan for the overall development of the college in the academic session 2020-2021. The well structured and thought out plan for the session adopted to be accomplished with the limited resources available at the college highlighted the priorities and needs of the college. The areas where the Strategic Plan emphasised in the session are:

- Keeping in mind the importance of the use of ICT Tools in the field of education, the college has decided to enhance this facility available at the college. Presently, there are already 3 ICT enabled classrooms in the college. Now, the college will try to increase this number by creating 2 new ICT enabled classrooms with wi-fi connection and smart T.V.
- The college has adopted the plan of installing pad incinerator and pad vending machine in the toilet room of ladies staff.
- In the present academic session, the college will try to introduce Honours Courses in the subjects Zoology, Botany and Physics. Presently, these disciplines of Science Stream are operating with regular courses. Keeping in mind the demands made by the students, the college will try to introduce Honours Courses in these three subjects. For this, the college authority will communicate with the Director of Higher Education, Government of Assam and with their help, will take up all the necessary measures
- Another important strategic plan adopted for the session is to install solar lights in the college. This step is taken for the proper use of solar energy and to lighten the whole campus in the night time. Initially, the college will install 10 solar lights in the campus. For this, the college will take necessary action.

- The college has adopted the plan of installing CCTV cameras in every corner of the college to monitor the activities within the college campus which may threaten the peace and security of the college.
- The college has also decided to organise self-defence classes among the girl students of the college. One trainee will be invited to take the classes regularly. The students will be provided with certificates after the successful completion of the training programme.
- For the fulfilment of the college vision and mission for spreading education in the greater Barbhag region, the college has decided to introduce Integrated B.Ed Course in the present session. For this, the college will take all the necessary actions.
- The College has also adopted plan to make the whole campus of the college wi-fi enabled in the present session. There is provision of wi-fi in some selected areas of the campus which is not accessible by all the faculties and the students. Therefore, in the session, the authority has decided to increase the number of wi-fi connections in the college to make the whole campus wi-fi enabled.
- Keeping in mind the importance of life-skills, the college decided to organise life-skill development programmes for the benefits of students.
- The college will also organise awareness programmes among the people of nearby villages to create awareness on different topics to maintain a scientific and reasonable attitude among people.
