
Departmental Seminar On "Einstein's Theory of Relativity" Date: 20-09-2018 Resource Person: Dr. Mahendra Kalita

#### A seminar on "Einstein's Theory of Relativity" was organized by the department of Physics, Barbhag College in the conference hall on 20-09-2018. The aim of the seminar was to enlighten the students on the greatest contribution of Einstein to the world of Physics. The programme was inaugurated by Pulama Talukdar, Assistant Professor Department of Physics, Barbhag College at 2:00pm. In her inaugural talk she briefly discussed the life history of the great scientist and threw light on his different contributions to the world of Physics. She just introduced students to the term 'Relativity'. As a resource person, Dr. Mahendra Kalita, Associate Professor, Department of Physics, Rangia College introduced students to both the theories- General Relativity and Special relativity. He told that general relativity is actually Einstein's Theory of gravity and it says that the observed gravitational effect between two masses results from their warping of space-time. The time dependent solutions of general relativity enable us to talk about the history of the universe. Einstein's theory has the prediction of Black holes, gravitational lensing and existence of gravitational waves. In addition, general relativity has provided the base of cosmological models of an expanding universe. He also beautifully discussed the special relativity .He said that combined with the other laws of physics, the two postulates of special relativity predicts the equivalence of mass and energy as expressed in the mass energy equivalence formula. He concluded his lecture saying special relativity as the most accurate model of motion at any speed or especially at a speed close to that of light. The seminar was attended by 27 students and 03 teachers of the department. The lecture of the resource person was followed by an interaction session where all the students and teachers participated actively. The programme ended with the Vote of Thanks delivered by Mahananda Pathak, HOD, Physics Barbhag College.

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Barbhag College has organised a one-day interdisciplinary seminar on Intellectual Property rights (IPR) on 10<sup>th</sup> December 2018. At the beginning of the Seminar, the Keynote address was given by Dr. Karuna Baruah, HOD, Mathematics Department of Barbhag College and the welcome address was given by Hemanta Deka, Assistant coordinator, IQAC, Barbhag College. Dr. Bipul Kalita Associate Professor of Assamese department chaired the sessions of the seminar.

Prof. Mahananda Pathak, Assistant professor, department Physics of Barbhag College, is invited as resource person of the seminar. Mahananda Pathak has discussed the theoretical background of Intelectual Property Rights especially patent and copy right. Describing Intellectual Property, he said that the intellectual properties are those things that are created in mind and expressed in some form or other. It must have the proof of ownership and should be recognised under the act of law. He talked about the rights enjoyed by people under intellectual property, like rights to enjoy the owner of an intellectual property, right to exploit, license, assign, surrender etc as the owner. He also mentioned about different acts which protects the intellectual property such as- The Patent Act (1970), The Design Act (2000), The Trademark Act (1999), and The Geographical Indications of Goods (Registration and Protection act, 1999) etc. He said that the copyright procedure in India is maintained by the Copyright Act of 1957. He mentioned that people can cite other's works with proper acknowledgement and prior permission of the owner of the copyright for research or private study, for reporting current events and in connection with judicial proceedings. A total of 45 participants from various colleges took part in this Seminar and made it a huge success.

The vote of thanks is offered by Dr. Biplab Deka, Associate professor, Department of Economics, and thanks everybody for their presence and patient hearing. The seminar comes to an end with an optimistic note.

The topic of the class seminar was "Globalization and State: Current Challenges". Mr. NirenMalakar, Associate Professor of the Dept. of Political Science of Barbhag College was present in this class seminar as resource person.


On 20/04/2019, Saturday, a class seminar was organized by the Department of Political science of Barbhag College among the honours students of the department. The topic for the class seminar was "Federalism and Indian Experiences" and the resource person of the class seminar was Mr. HementaDeka, HOD and Associate Professor of the Political Science Department.

Mr. HemantaDeka, started his speech by addressing and introducing the topic of the class seminar to the students. He explained the term 'federalism' as a form of government in which two separate governments rule-one at the center and the other at the federating units or regional level. A true federalism, to Mr. Deka is the example of constitutional division of powers between the two governments and both the governments enjoy separate powers. They act independently in their own sphere. Mr. HemantaDeka, then talked about the Indian experiences with federalism. He described it as "Centralized Federalism". In this powerdivision and relation, the central government enjoys mare powers over the state governments. The provisions of power-division between the center and the states in the Constitution of India make the center more powerful and more authoritative. The lists of power division between the center and states, unified judiciary are the examples of the presence of strong central government in India.

Mr. HemantaDeka, then talked about the problems associated with Indian federalism. To Him, regionalism is the main challenging issue of federalism. It encourages the people of different regions who are deprived of different facilities to revolt against the central government. Thus, the nation has to face internal security challenges in terms of growing destructive activities.

Mr. HemantaDeka, also identified central planning as a challenge towards federalism in India. The provision of separate constitution for Jammu and Kashmir is also violating the federal character of the Indian Constitution. In this way, Mr. HemantaDeka enlightened the students with his knowledge on the seminar topic.

BidishaLahkar, student of the Political Science Department presented a paper titled "Indian Federalism: Constitutional Provisions" in this class seminar. Thus, the class seminar ended in a positive note.

### Report of the Programme

Today, on 02/12/2019, a Departmental Seminar is held in the Department of English at 11-30 A.M. at the Conference Room of Barbhag College, under the chairmanship of Prof. Ajit Kumar Sarma. The topic for today's seminar is "Post Independence Indian English Poetry." A total of 27 students and 3 teachers participated in the seminar. The speaker in the seminar is Mrs. Nivedita Goswami who has delivered a lecture on the above mentioned topic.

At the very beginning the Chairperson Prof Ajit Kumar Sarma announced the name of the speaker i.e. Prof. Nivedita Goswami and explained the aims and objectives of the seminar. He gave the students a gist on Indian English poetry during the post-Independence Era and asked the speaker to deliver her speech.

Prof. Goswami began the seminar with a brief explanation on the background to Indian English poetry. She said that poetry is the expression of human life from times eternal. In the initial phase or the first phase of Indian poetry was the period of literary renaissance in India. Derozio's poems Kashiprasad Ghose's poems, Michael Madhusudan Dutta's 'The Captive Lady' are a testimony to the creative upsurge occasioned by the romantic spirit killed by the literary Renaissance. The poets of the second phase were Sarojini Naidu, Rabindranath Tagore, Aurobindo Ghose and Harindranath Chattopadhya. The poetic output of these poets was prolific. Romanticism of these Indian poets was fraught with nationalism spirituality and mysticism. It was therefore different from English Romanticism. The ethos of the post-



Independence phase of Indian English literature is radically different from the first two phases, when the question of political Independence was resolved in 1947 with the partition of India, the tensions of the Indian psyche suddenly relaxed. In this new spirit and confidence the Indian poets found themselves in line with modern English and American poets. Mrs. Goswami concluded her lecture by pointing out the importance of Indian English poetry in the post –independence Era.

At the end of the Seminar, some of the student participants asked some questions and the speaker Mrs. Nivedita Goswwami answered their quarries. It was a good interactive session and the seminar was a grand success. The programme ended at 2-00 P.M. with Prof. Anupam Dutta offering the vote of thanks to everyone.

Report of the Programme

Today, the 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2020, a popular lecture programme is organized by the department of English on the subject "T.S. Eliot and the Metaphysical Poetry." The programme is held in the Departmental Class room of the English department. Altogether 39 students and 4 teachers of the department of English have participated in the programme. The programme commences at about 11-30 A.M., and the proceeding starts with a brief introductory speech by Mr. Sarma, Associate Professor, Department of English, Barbhag College. In his introductory speech Mr. Ajit Kumar Sarma has applauded the initiative of his department for organizing this lecture programme and briefly recounts the great contributions of the Metaphysical Poets to the sphere of English poetry. Mr. Sarma has made special mention of John Donne's fantastic poetic ability in composing a class of poetry which was beyond the tradition of the then contemporary English poetry.

After that the invited guest and resource person of the programme Dr. Ranjana Bhattacharyya has delivered her scholarly deliberation on the topic. Dr. Bhattacharyya, in her speech, highlights the primary aspects of T.S. Eliot's criticism on the 17<sup>th</sup> century Metaphysical Poets with reference to their exceptional poetic ability. The key points of her discussion are the concepts like- "the unification of sensibility", dissociation of sensibility", "mechanism of sensibility", "metaphysical conceit" etc.

By 'Unification of sensibility', T. S. Eliot means 'a fusion of thought and feeling', 'are creation of thought into feeling', and 'a direct sensuous apprehension of thought'. Dr. Bhattacharyya explains how T.S.Eliot argued that the Metaphysical poets, together with the Elizabethan and the Jacobean dramatists, had a mechanism of sensibility which could accommodate any kind of experience. Eliot points out to Donne's most successful and characteristic effect secured by brief words and sudden contrasts: A bracelet of bright hair about the bone, where the most powerful effect is produced by the sudden contrast of associations of 'bright hair' and of 'bone'... This telescoping of images and multiplied associations were characteristic of some of the dramatists of the Elizabethan period like Shakespeare, Middleton and Webster, and is one of the sources of the vitality of their



language. She further states that the poets of the seventeenth century (up to the Revolution) were the direct and normal development of the preceding age. However, a dissociation of sensibility set in after the age of Donne, in the late 17th century; there was a split between thought and feeling. The influence of Dryden and Milton has been particularly harmful in this respect.

Dr. Ranjana Bhattacharyya is of the view that Eliot's 'dissociation of sensibility' was a result of the natural development of poetry after the Metaphysical poets, who had felt "their thought as immediately as the odour of a rose"; this phenomenon—the "direct sensuous apprehension of thoughtEliot gave evidence of the dissociation of sensibility in the more elevated language and cruder emotions of later poets.

The lecture programme finally concludes with an interactive session with the invited guest and a good many students also share their knowledge.

Dr. Nandita Goswami, in her thoughtful speech, clearly elaborated the meaning of the phrase "North-South Divide" in the international relations among the students. Dr. Goswami, clearly demarcated the 'north' and the 'south' as "rich countries" and the "poor countries", where the 'north' is taken to include the industrialized, high per capita income, national political economies of which most of the countries are situated in the northern hemisphere and the 'south' describes those countries with the high level of poverty and comparatively low level of industrialization, large number of which are situated in the southern hemisphere.

Focusing on the global north and global south divide in historical context, Dr. Nandita Goswami stressed on the dependency theory where colonial powers extracted resources from the colonial countries. Assuming the unequal relationships and exchanges between the north and the south, dependency theory calls upon for a delinking from northern institutions and for the launch of a self-centered development strategy which concentrate on the needs and demands of the domestic population. It demands for the establishment of a new international economic order for the better facilities of the global south.

Dr. Nandita Goswami also participated in an interactive session with the students. In this seminar, NanditaPatowary presented her paper on "North-South Divide: Role of India". Thus, with the presence of the faculty and students, the class seminar ended in an positive note.

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

#### The Proceedings in brief:

The two days National Seminar was organised by the Department of History, Barbhag College scheduled on 21<sup>st</sup> & 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2022 and rescheduled due to Covid protocol which was held on 11<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> February, 2022 with the Title of *"August Kranti Movement and Its Multi Faceted Dimensions in Assam reflected in the Freedom Struggle of India"* sponsored by Indian Council of Historical Research (ICHR), New Delhi at the Barbhag College Premises.

India is now celebrating 75 years of its independence from the colonial regime. It is the time to commemorate the sacrifices of those martyrs and great soul as well those phases of hardship which could be the spirit of inspiration for the new generation. History is a preserver of the record and analysis of human civilization and freedom struggle is one of the

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important phases that make the very existence of today's India as a Nation. Thus history has to keep those phases in its order for future generation as a spirit of inspiration.

Assam, an integral part of the Indian Nation has entered into the nationhood during the colonial period. It is situated in the north eastern borderline of the greater India geographically and has been touched by the colonial hegemony of the British somewhat lately by 1826. Having the connectivity of Assam with the greater India, it has been inspired by the each and every resistance endeavour of the Indian people against the British and the heroes of this corner of India also selflessly did engage, lead and sacrifice in all the sphere of the Freedom Movement.

This seminar has provided a platform to commemorate the martyrs of the Indian freedom movement with its multifaceted dimensions and locating August Kranti Movement particularly in Assam and placing it in the history of freedom struggle of India in general with a holistic approach of history writing. The seminar has given an opportunity to draw out the picture of the August Kranti Movement at the micro level and helps to find out unsung heroes of each and every corner of Assam. The impact and participation of Assam in the various facet of the movement that leads us to an inclusive history of freedom struggle and energize the new generation of each and every corner of India with the great legacy of martyrdom of their soil. The Book exhibition of ICHR, NERC that we invited and organised along with the seminar had helped in popularising the subject and successfully attracted the students in this sphere of knowledge.



Inaugural Ceremony

As the Inaugural Session started at 10 A.M. on Day one, the guest and participants of the seminar were welcome with a morning message by the Co-ordinator Dr. Namita Devi at the very beginning and then the seminar was started with the lightening of the lamp followed by an inaugural session. Dr. Birendra Deka, President of Governing Body and Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Principal of Barbhag College lit the inaugural lamp along with all dignitaries present in the session with 'Deepa Stuti' performed by Dr. Namita Devi, Coordinator of the seminar. The Session was hosted by Dr. Anupam Dutta, IQAC Co-ordinator of Barbhag College. The Inaugural session was started by a patriotic song 'Viswa Bijay Na-Jwan' performed by the students of Barbhag College and the lyrics of the song was written by renown laureate and freedom fighter Jyotiprasad Agarwala. The welcome address was given by Nivedita Goswami, Vice Principal of Barbhag College and in her address she highlighted the importance of the topic to the young generation. She also said that our nation not only having to face the external enemies but a lot of internal detractors as well. So knowing our nation with its strength and weaknesses, the study and research in historical facts are very important. In her speech, she highlighted the importance of August Kranti Movement which was a mass movement in the true sense against the British and mentioned that the participation of Assam in the phases of August Kranti where the Britisher's saw the might of the Assamese people. She also briefed up about the College and welcomed all the dignitaries and participants gathered for the seminar with a humble request to bear with the shortcomings of the institutional infrastructure. Dr. Sanjib Goswami, in his talk as Chief Guest discussed that "An important aspect of the Quit India movement was the way the movement was implemented. This was designed and implemented through various programmes in a pyramidcal structure... The role of the subalterns and the protests of the marginalised and people in the fringes were ignored. Any activity that did not fall within the pyramid structure set up by the Congress was considered against the spirit of the movement. It is for this reason that any form of violence such as those relating to the Chauri-Chaura incident, the derailment of the train in Morigaon, the martyrdom of many in Assam including Kushal Konwar, Kanaklata Barua, Bhogeswari Phukanani, Rebati Lahon, Kahuli Devi and several others do not find mention in the national historical narratives of the Quit India movement. This therefore gives us further scope to research the neglect of events in the periphery like Assam or of those by the marginalised and subaltern people. As the Azadika Amrit Mahotsav is

being celebrated, this seminar should also research into a critical analysis of the Quit India movement in the light of international historical protests worldwide. The events in South Africa against apartheid, the Russian Revolution, the two nation resolution of the Muslim League in 1940, as well as the visit of Veer Savarkar to Assam in 1941, just prior to the Quit India movement are all events that hold much research potential and thus throws light on the multidimensional aspects of the Freedom Struggle in general and Quit India Movement in particular. Dr. Barnali Sarma, Associate Professor, Dept. of History, Gauhati University as a key note speaker highlighted about the importance of the phase and said that 'as the seminar is on the August revolution we need to question what is so very specific of the movement. The seminar also attempts to probe into its multifaceted dimensions in Assam. So here I would like to set a pen picture of the time on which the scholars will address the different issues and of course with different perspectives in this two day seminar. Quit India or Bharat Choro are the simple but powerful slogan which launched this legendary struggle which we also call the August revolution. The quit India movement was started in a situation when Great Britain was engaged in a life and death struggle for its survival against the Axis power comprising Germany, Italy and Japan. Cripps mission who came with British war cabinets' proposal on Indian question too failed as it did not carry any hope of independence after the end of the war. The situation in Assam was also critical as it was afrontier province. During this period it was in the grip of three terrible crisis- (1) the police repression consequent on launching the quit India Movement for freedom and independence (2) the economic and social dislocation caused by the imperial war effort coupled with the Japanese aggression and evacuees problem and (3) the famine problems and its impact on the life and activities of the people of the province. She also said that the Quit India movement though it did not bring independence in its immediate result, but it lowered the prestige of the colonial regime and shattered the so called invincibility of Great Britain'.

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The First technical session of the seminar had begun after the inaugural session. The session was started with the moderation of Sanchyita Khakholary, Assistant Professor, Dept. of History, and Barbhag College. The chairperson to this session was Dr. Sanjib Goswami, Professor and Head of the Centre for North-East, Mahapurusha Srimanta Shankardeva Vishwavidyalaya and the resource person was Dr. Akunthita Barthakur, Associate Professor, Dept. of History, and Cotton State University.



Dr. Akunthita Barthakur as the resource person talked about the Assamese people and their sacrifices made during the Quit India Movement. The session had a total number of eight papers. The first paper was presented by Phulrenu Mishra, BBK Collegeand the theme of the paper was "August Kranti Movement: Struggle and Sacrifices (with special reference

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to Barpeta District). Again Barasha Barman, M.A. student of Gauhati University presented her paper on "People of Barnagar during Quit India Movement". Then we have Jayshree Singha, presenting her paper on the topic, "August Kranti or Quit India Movement of Assam. The title of the other paper presented in this first session were "Contribution of Unsung Heroines of Quit India Movement 1942 from Darrang District of Assam"; 'Gandhian Nationalist Movement and Raja Rao's Kanthapura';the Role played by the Student of Cotton College, Assam during the August Kranti'etc. The papers presented in this session has been highlighted and locate the participation of Assamese people of the micro level area of Assam in the August Kranti Movement and put forward the mass people representation in the Quit India Movement.



The Chairperson and the resource person gave their comments and advised the paper presenter. Dr. Goswami talked about how to write a good research paper and advised to follow research format in writing research paper. Dr. Barthakur pointing out the lacunas of each paper, advised the paper presenter to write a good research paper by following the proper methodology such as putting foot notes, references etc. The second technical session has begun after a short lunch break with the moderation of Monalisha Brahma, Assistant Professor, Dept. of History, and Barbhag College. Dr. Bhaskarjyoti Sarma, Associate professor, Anandaram Barua Institute of Language, Art and Culture, North Guwahati was the Chairperson of this session and the resource person was Dr. Akunthita Barthakur. This session had four research papers on different sub-themes related to Quit India and August Kranti Movement.



The first paper presenter was Pratyasha Takuldar, presenting her paper on "Role of language, literature and Culture in the August Kranti Movement with emphasis on Jyotiprasad Agarwala". Dr. Jamaluddin Ahmed, Assistant Professor, Chamariya Anchalik College, presented a paper on "Role Language, Literature and Culture, in the Quit India Movement of Assam". The next paper presenter was Rafat Subayyil who talked about the "Role of Mrityu Bahini , the death Squad of Assam. The Last paper of this session was "the Role of Tea tribes in Quit India Movement in Assam " and was presented by Pranab Jyoti Phukan.



At the end of the Session, Chairperson Dr. Bhaskarjyoti Sarma analysing the whole session and put forward his observation on doing good research and urged the researcher to

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do research narrowing the scope of the study. He advised that the presenter should be careful in selecting the theme; to narrow down the topic, again he said the researcher should be clean in the way that it may have impact for a longer period of time.



The second day of the National seminar began with 3<sup>rd</sup> technical session, which was moderated by Dr. Anupam Dutta Co- ordinator of IQAC, Barbhag College. The session was started with a speech of Dr. Kamal Nayan Patowary, Principal, Nalbari College on the role of August Kranti Movement in Historical Research.

A total number of five papers were presented in this session. Noopur Singh, Assistant Director, ICHR, New Delhi presented her lecture as one of the Resource person on "26th September, 1942 Remembering Unsung Heroes of Mrityu Bahini, Assam" through online mode. Then Bedika Bhattacharyee, Researcher of Gauhati University presented her paper on "August Kranti, Gandhian and the Rise of Feminist Nationalism in Assam". Emphasising the 'Role of unsung heroes', Abdul Rouf and Tilak Sarma, presented their paper on "Sahidur Rahman:The First Assamese Martyr of Azad Hind Fauz". Sumi Das on her paper highlighted the Role of Women in August Kranti. The last paper of this session was presented by Abu Shama Ahmed,Moriom Nessa and Abida Ahmed. The theme of their paper was "the Role of Assam in Historic Quit India Movement".

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At the end commenting on the papers presented, Chairperson Dr. Kamal Nayan Patowary indentified the scope of historical research in present day context. Resource person Dr. Rabin Sarma, Principal, Damdama College talked about history of the Freedom Struggle to be analysed from the Indian perspectives. Monalisha Brahama, Assistant Professor Dept. of History, has delivered vote of thanks in this 3<sup>rd</sup> technical session. After short tea Break of 15 minutes, the Valedictory session was started. This session was presided by Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Pricipal Barbhag College, Nivedita Goswami, former Pricipal i/c and Vice Principal Barbhag College. The Session was hosted by Dr. Chandan Kalita, Assistant Professor, Dept. of English Barbhag College. The Valedictory lecture was given by Vice Principal Nivedita Goswami, where she highlighted the outcome of the seminar. She referred that the seminar has explored the history of Quit India Movement of Assam indicating the various aspects such as unsung heroes, local contributions, unsung heroes of Azad Hind Fauz and above all the involvement of women in a large and prominent scale in this phase of Freedom Struggle. The President of the Rapporteur Ajit kr. Sarma read out the Report of the two days Seminar and reviewed the outcome of the seminar as a whole and then certificates were distributed to the paper presenter. With the vote of Thanks given by Dr. Namita Devi, coordinator of the seminar and the Seminar had been closed down with the National Anthem by all the people of Valedictory Session.

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


The proceedings of Day-2 closed with Dr. Kishore Kalita giving the vote of thanks. The participants were mailed e-certificates of participation after the programme concluded.



## AN INTERDISCIPLINARY WORKSHOP ON INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS (IPR)

Organised By IQAC, Barbhag College Date: 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2022

Keeping in view the importance of Intellectual Property Rights, the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Barbhag College has organised a one-day interdisciplinary workshop on Intellectual Property rights (IPR) on 10<sup>th</sup> January, 2022. The workshop was held by keeping in mind the restriction imposed by the district administration due to the outbreak of the third wave of COVID-19. Though limited in numbers, faculty of different colleges attended the workshop. At the beginning of the workshop, the Keynote address was given by Ajit Sarma, HOD, English Department of Barbhag College and the welcome address was given by Nivedita Goswami, Principal-in-charge of Barbhag College. Dr. Dhaneswar Baisya, Associate Professor of Political Science department chaired the sessions of the workshop.

The workshop was divided into two technical sessions. In the first session, Siddhartha Devnath, Scientist 'C', Patent Information Centre, Assam Science, Technology and Environment Council (ASTEC) was presented as the Special guest, who graced the occasion with his vast knowledge on the discussed topic of the workshop. The topic of his speech was "Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) and Patent". Describing Intellectual Property, he said that the intellectual properties are those things that are created in mind and expressed in some form or other. It must have the proof of ownership and should be recognised under the act of law. He cited the examples of light bulbs, pen, jewellery, etc as intellectual property. Elaborating ideas on intellectual rights, he also mentioned some forms of intellectual property, like inventions, designs, mark used in trade-brand name, mark used in goods to show its geographical origin, layout designs of integrated Circuit (IC), new varieties of plants, and literary, artistic, musical creation as well. He also talked about the rights enjoyed by people under intellectual property, like rights to enjoy the owner of an intellectual property, right to exploit, license, assign, surrender etc as the owner. Talking about the different types of intellectual property, he also mentioned the legislations enacted by the Government of India for maintaining intellectual property. Examples of such legislations are The Patent Act (1970), The Design Act (2000), The Trademark Act (1999), and The Geographical Indications of Goods (Registration and Protection act, 1999) etc that play key



role in maintaining intellectual property ownership. By imparting his knowledge on one of the major concepts of intellectual property i.e. "Copyright" he mentioned about patent and also about its significance for owners. He described patent as a legal grant of exclusive rights foe an invention (product or process) provided by the government to the creator of a new and useful invention. Under the Patent Act of 1970, the inventor gets patent rights for a period of 20 years. He also elaborately discussed some criteria of patent, like novelty, inventive step, industrial applicability etc. In his speech, he also made a difference between the inventions that can be patented and those which cannot be patented. At the end, he talked about the different stages of patent from application to grant, fees and process of patent.

After a short break, the second session of the workshop began. Dipen Deka, Assistant Professor, Department of Library and Information Science of Gauhati University was the special guest in this session. The topic of his speech was "Copyright". He discussed copyright mainly in relation to literary and fictional creations. To him, the copyright procedure in India is maintained by the Copyright Act of 1957. He mentioned that people can cite other's works with proper acknowledgement and prior permission of the owner of the copyright for research or private study, for reporting current events and in connection with judicial proceedings. He identified the creators who are given copyright rights. Those are: a music composer, a film producer, a sound producer, a photographer and also an author who creates literary works. He also mentioned that copyright is also assignable for future work too. The term of copyright in literary works is 60 years and the performer's right is 25 years. Again, he also talked about "Plagiarism" and what causes plagiarism and advised people the method how to avoid the fault of plagiarism.

A total of 40 participants from various colleges took part in this one-day workshop and made it a huge success.

State Level Workshop on Revised Assessment and Accreditation Framework of NAAC 2022 Organised by Assam College Teachers' Association, Nalbari Zone In Collaboration with IQAC, Barbhag College

Date: 11<sup>th</sup> June, 2022

A state level workshop on "Revised Assessment and Accreditation Framework of NAAC 2022" was organized by Nalbari Zone of Assam College Teachers' Association (ACTA) in collaboration with IQAC, Barbhag College in the Conference Hall of Barbhag College on the 11<sup>th</sup> of June, 2022. A total Number of 51 participants took part in the workshop. Prof.(Dr.) Utpal Sarma was the Resource Person in the workshop, which was chaired by Dr. Dhaneswar Kalita, President of Nalbari Zone of ACTA.

#### **Inaugural Session**

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The inaugural session started with the President of Barbhag College Governing Body lighting the ceremonial lamp at 10.30 a.m. It was followed by the welcome address delivered by Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Principal of Barbhag College. Dr. Kamal Nayan Patowary, Principal of Nalbari College, Assam formally inaugurated the workshop. In his inaugural speech Dr. Patowary stressed on the fact that for an HEI to progress systematically and consistently, it is very important that the institution regularly keeps assessing itself and gets itseld assessed by an external agency from time to time. He said that the role of NAAC in this respect is very crucial. For almost three decades now NAAC has been taking quality initiatives to uplift the HEIs qualitatively. It is necessary for each and every institution to keep itself abreast of the latest trends in qulity culture in higher education. He contrulated ACTA and Barbhag College for having conceived this workshop on a very pertinent subject.

### **Technical Session**

The technical Session which started at 11.00 a.m., was chaired by Dr. Dhaneswar Kalita, President of Nalbari Zone of ACTA. Prof (Dr.) Utpal Sarma gave an elaborate presentation on the latest assessment and accreditation framework of Naac. Prof. Sarma, Who is the former Coordinator of IQAC, Gauhati University, explained evry criterion in the SSR format issued by Naac on June 1, 2022. He showed how the SSR has to be prepared keeping in mind the strengths and weaknesses of an HEI. He said that it is



very important that each HEI prepares and submits the AQARs regularly so that the process of preparing the SSR becomes easier. He particularly emphasized the fact that smaller HEIs should exploit their srtenths and utilize the minimal resources at their disposal to the optimum level. He drew the attention of the participants to certain critical key indicators which the HEIs have to focus on throughout a year in order to be able to make progress on those areas and thereby to uplift the quality of the institution. Prof. Sarma explained every key indicator and its importance in improving the overall quality of an institution. He also clearly explained the latest procedure of applying for assessment and accreditation by NAAC.

Following his presentation, Dr. Sarma handed out some questionnaire to the participants and asked them to fill up those questionnaire in order to see if the participants have actually understood the procedure of preparing the SSR clearing answering every key question under each key indicator in every criterion. The participants asked several questions regarding certain critical questions in some criteria. The participants particularly wanted to know how smaller HEIs score good marks with limited financial resources. Dr. Sarma made it clear that more financial resources do not mean higher grades. Even snmaller HEIs can get good grades if they can make optimum utilization of the limited resources at their disposal.

The technical session ended at 1.45 p.m. with the chair making the concluding remarks where he requested the participants to share whatever they from the workshop with their colleagues in their respective institutions.







On 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 (Wednesday), a workshop is organized by the department of History on the theme "how to prepare a presentation" at Conference Hall, Barbhag College.
