6. Arrangement of requisite infrastructure and other professional activities for faculty members as per need of the institution.
7. Student exchange program, whereby students in both institutions could be benefited by having access to learning resources in each other's institutions.

(b) The cost of cooperative activities may be funded as mutually determined. All cooperative activities under this MoU will be subject to the availability of funds of the institutions.

(c) This MoU may be amended by mutual written consent of the colleges.

(d) This MoU will come into effect from the date it is signed.

(e) This MoU will remain in effect for an initial period of 5 (five) years and may be extended, on mutual consent, for successive periods spanning not less than one year.

(f) The MoU may be terminated by mutual agreement of both institutions. However, under no circumstances, termination can take place less than one year after it is signed.

Faculty Exchange Program

Department of History of Barbhag College, Kalag, Nalbari, conducted a Faculty Exchange Program, for the 5th semester student in the History Department MNC College Nalbari. For the Exchange program, Namita Devi, HOD, History Barbhag College, as a Resource Person conducted one hour class for the students of 5th semester MNC College. The class started at around 2pm. The focus of the lecture was on “Commercialization of Agriculture in Colonial India”. The lecture session covered the topic of commercialization of agriculture during British Rule, its negative and positive impact in Indian Society. She lectured on how the various economic policies of British led to the rapid transformation of India’s economy into a colonial economy whose nature and structure were determined by the needs of the British economy. She then goes on to explain that when industrial revolution was gaining its pace in England, commercialization of agriculture started in India. It became prominent in an around 1860. The main aim of such policies was not to feed the industries of India but was done primarily to feed the British Industries. She says that every policy have a positive and negative effects. She highlighted the negative impact of commercialization of agriculture such as exploitation of poor as the poor peasant was forced to sell his produce just after harvest at whatever price he could get as he had to meet the demands of government moneylenders and his family requirement. It also led to loss of land if the peasant failed to meet the demand the land came under the ownership of money lender. Some of the positive impact of commercialization of agriculture was that the commercialization linked India with the world economy, it led to the introduction of large number of commercial crops such as tea, indigo, cotton, coffee. She concluded the lecture by saying that the commercialization of agriculture was a new phenomenon in Indian society introduced by British from which the upper section of the Indian society was benefitted and the peasant life was tied to remote international market. The worst effect of commercialization was the oppression of peasants at the hands of Europeans and rich moneylenders. The one hour session came to an end at around 3pm with more new knowledge for the students.

(f) The MoU may be terminated by mutual agreement of both institutions. However, under no circumstances, termination can take place less than one year after it is signed.

The MoU is signed by **Mrs. Nivedita Goswami**, Principal, Barbhag College and **Md. Tazimuddin Ahmed**, Secretary, SANDHAN

(a) The MoU will encourage the following cooperative activities, in particular:

1. Policy dialogue to regularly exchange information and experience on mass education as well as social challenges and to identify priorities for bilateral cooperation in the field of health, education, awareness, capacity building and social mobilization.
2. Exchange and professional development of officials, resource persons, experts, students, faculty and NGO workers.
3. Organisation of joint awareness/sensitization programme, capacity building training, exhibitions and symposia on matters of mutual interest. Moreover the parties agree to work together for mass-awareness in respect of sensitive social, educational, and economic issues and will take initiatives for transfer of knowledge in different fields.
4. Arrangement of requisite infrastructure for above mentioned activities as per need of the college and the organisation.
5. Arrangement of Student exposure program, student internship program of the college or exposure program of social training groups of the NGO whereby both the parties could be benefited by having access to learning resources in each other's institutions.

(b) The cost of cooperative activities may be funded as mutually determined. All cooperative activities under this MoU will be subject to the availability of funds of the college and the NGO. However as the NGO has limited financial resources, the college agrees to provide all expenses for necessary arrangement like venue, participants, resource persons, sound system and refreshment of participants etc. for all the activities to be done at college venue.


(c) This MoU may be amended by mutual written consent of the college and the NGO.


(d) This MoU will remain in effect for an initial period of 5 (five) years and may be extended, on mutual consent, for successive periods spanning not less than one year.

(d) The MoU may be terminated by mutual agreement of both the college and the NGO. However, under no circumstances, termination can take place less than one year after it is signed.

Congratulations to all the stakeholders of both the college and the NGO.

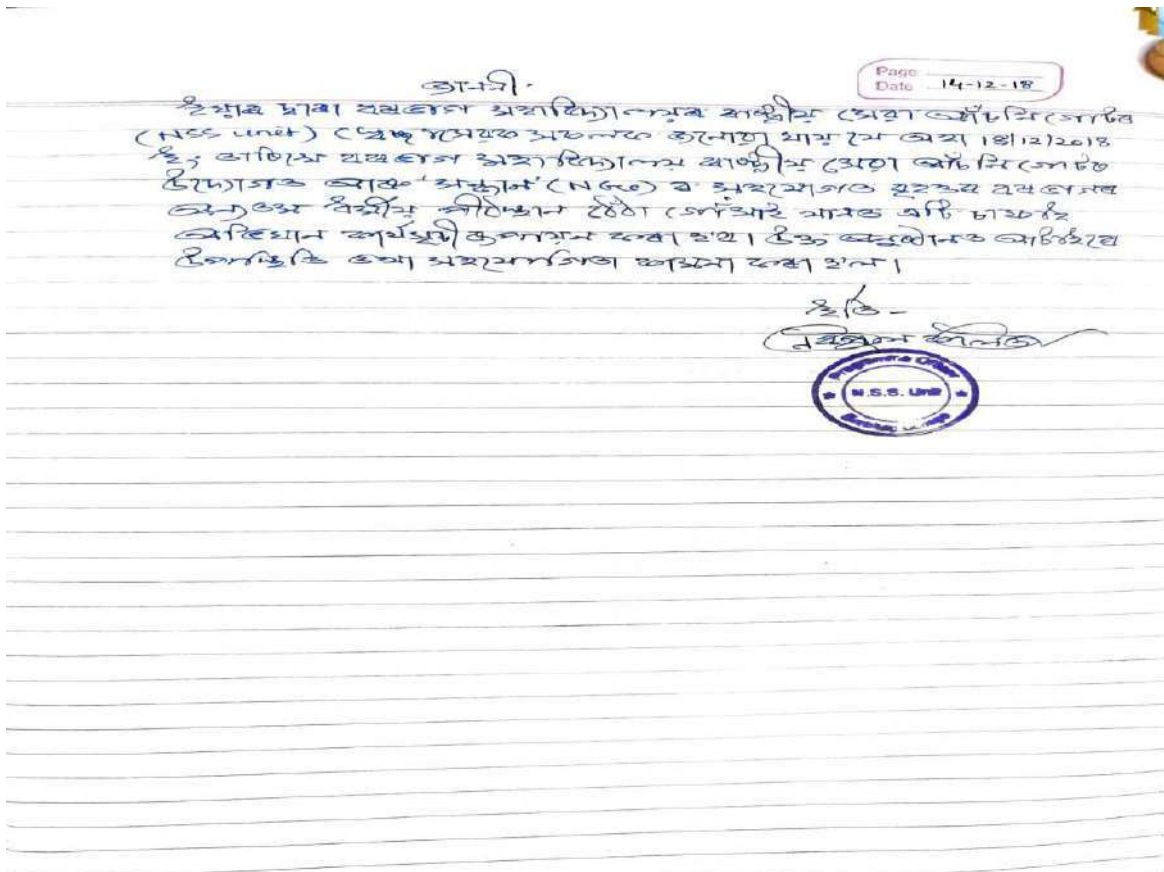

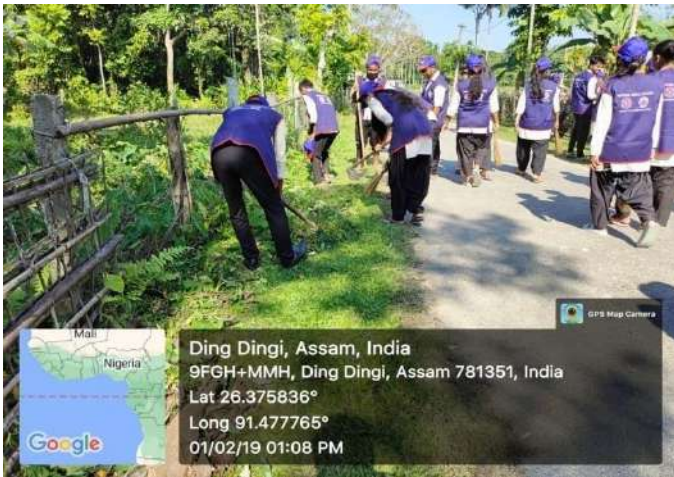

Report of Barbhag Book Fair

Organized Jointly by Barbhag College, Sandhan (NGO) and Arya Bhatta Science Center, Nalbari

Venue: Play Ground of Barbhag Kalag Higher Secondary School, Kalag, Nalbari
Date: 16, 17, 18 and 19 November 2021

A state level book fair, namely “Barbhag Book Fair”, was organized with a four day long programme, and in collaboration with two renowned non-government social organizations of Nalbari district, namely Sandhan (NGO), Bangnabari, Nalbari and Arya Bhatta Science Center, Nalbari. The Book Fair was organized in the play ground of Barbhag Kalag Higher Secondary School, Kalag, Nalbari, and the same was held on 16, 17, 18, and 19 November, 2021.

The main objective of organizing the Book Fair was to stir the interest of local Book lovers and readers in reading and purchasing more and more books, and also to make plethora of Books available in the door steps of local people and also for sale in a discount rate. The book fair was also organized to encourage the local upcoming writers and publishers for publishing new books. It also aims at organizing number of Academic and cultural programmes like seminars, talks, debating sessions, quiz, and special interactive sessions etc. for the benefit of local students and public.

Altogether 12 Book stalls from different parts of the state took part in the Fair and set up their stalls for display and sale of different books. Along with the book stalls few other stalls were also set up to showcase Assamese traditional dress and food-stuffs. The Book Fair was commenced with the hoisting the Book Fair Flag. Three other flags, of the three collaborating agencies, were also hoisted. The four flags were hoisted by four distinguished personalities. The main flag of the Book Fair was hoisted by Dr. Dhaneswar Baishya, the President of the Book Fair organizing committee. The other three flags hoisted were of the three organizing partners, including the flag of Barbhag College, hoisted by Mr. Nivedita Goswami, the Principal In-Charge of Barbhag College, the flag of Sandhan (NGO), which was being hoisted by Mirza Musaddikur Rahman, the president of Sandhan, and the flag of Arya Bhatta Science Center, which was being hoisted by Dr. Dinamoni Bhagawati, the president of Arya Bhatta Science Center, Nalbari district.

At about 10 AM a plantation Programme was conducted in the premises of Barbhag Kalag Higher Secondary School Campus and 10 no. of plant seedlings of different indigenous variety were planted by different invited guests including the present President of Barbhag College Governing Body Dr. Birendra Deka, the present Principal of BKHSS Mr. Makibur Rahman, the present Secretary of Barbhag Yuva Samaj Mr. Mahendra Sarma etc.

At about 10-30 AM, Earthen Lamps were being lighted to show respect to all the martyrs of the Country. Dr. Pranab Sarma, Dr. Kamaldev Goswami, Dr. Madhuras Baishya, and Dr. Kameswar Lahkar along with few other invited guests took part in the plantation programme. Oblation of flowers was also made before a Swahid Bedi. At about 11 AM, the main gate of the Fook Fair was formally opened by Dr. Abani Bhagawati, professor, Dept.of Geography, Gauhati University, followed by an inaugural Meeting attended by some distinguished personalities like Mr. Naba Kumar Mazumdar, Mr. Pinku Choudhury (State Project Officer, Skill India), Mr. Nilim Akash Kashyap, a blooming new writer and a few others.

At about 11-30 AM, the book stalls are formally opened by Dr. Manabendra Deka, the principal of Swadeshi Academy Junior College, Guwahati. This was followed by the inauguration of the main arena including the Dais of the Book Fair. This is done by noted journalist and intellectual of the state Mr. Haider Hussain. The programme was attended by renowned personalities like Mr. Phanidhar Deka, retired Principal of Barbhag College, Mr. Prithi Bhusan Deka, President of one International Level NGO, namely G.V.M. At about 12-30 PM. An Interactive Programme with students and guardians was held for their academic benefit. This programme was followed by another interactive Session and the point of discussion was “Mother and Child health.” Renowned child specialist of

Assam Dr. Prakritish Bora attended the programme and shared his knowledge on the importance of mother and child health for building healthy future citizens.

At about 3-30 PM, a public meeting was organized for releasing the Souvenir of the Book Fair. Noted writer and academician of the state Dr. Basanta Kumar Bhattacharyya formally released the Souvenir of the Book Fair. At 5-30 in the evening earthen lamps were being lighted in front of a memorial photograph of Swahid Mukunda Kakati, showing respect to the famous martyr of India's freedom movement, who actually belonged to this area of the country. Mr. Bhupen Talukdar, one social activist of this area, lighted the lamps in front of a large gathering. At about 6-30 PM, one Open Quiz was held among the students and public and prizes were distributed amongst the winners.

On 17 November, 2021, the days programme commenced with a state level debate competition and the same was inaugurated by Dr. Manoj Mahanta, Principal, Pragjyotish College, Guwahati. The debated competition was held in memory of Late Dipmani Bhuyan, who worked as an Assistant Professor of Barbhag College and a good player. The gathering kept silence for a moment and prayed for a minute for eternal peace of the deceased. Dr. Sanjib Kumar Goswami, Assistant Professor, Department of English of Kamrup College, Chamata, Nalbari, chaired the competition, participated by some strong competitors from different parts of the state.

At 2-30 PM, one book release meeting was held to release five new books by five different writers. The books released were namely "Administration of Public Works Department in Assam since 1874-1984" by Dr. Dharanidhar Goswami, "Krishna Bahir Sur"- a poetry collection, by Dr. Chandan Kalita; "Bane Garaka Barbhagar Boka-Panir Majat Dangar Digha Hoi" by Mr. Nabin Chandra Lahkar; "Burhadia"- a poetry collection by Abdul Mazid; "Pa Mane Padyya"- a poetry collection for the child by Sri Hiranya Talukdar, and "Morom Barasun Hoi Sarana Tumi"- a poetry collection by Sri Pankaj Kumar Kalita. At about 7-30 P.M. one attractive programme on creative literature was organized for reading self-composed poetries by different invited and local poets. Altogether 34 poets took part in the programme. The programme was chaired by Dr. Chandan Kalita, Assistant Professor of Barbhag College and the same was inaugurated by the famous Actor of Assamese film industry Sri Kapil Bora. The programme was highly applauded by the poetry lovers of the area.

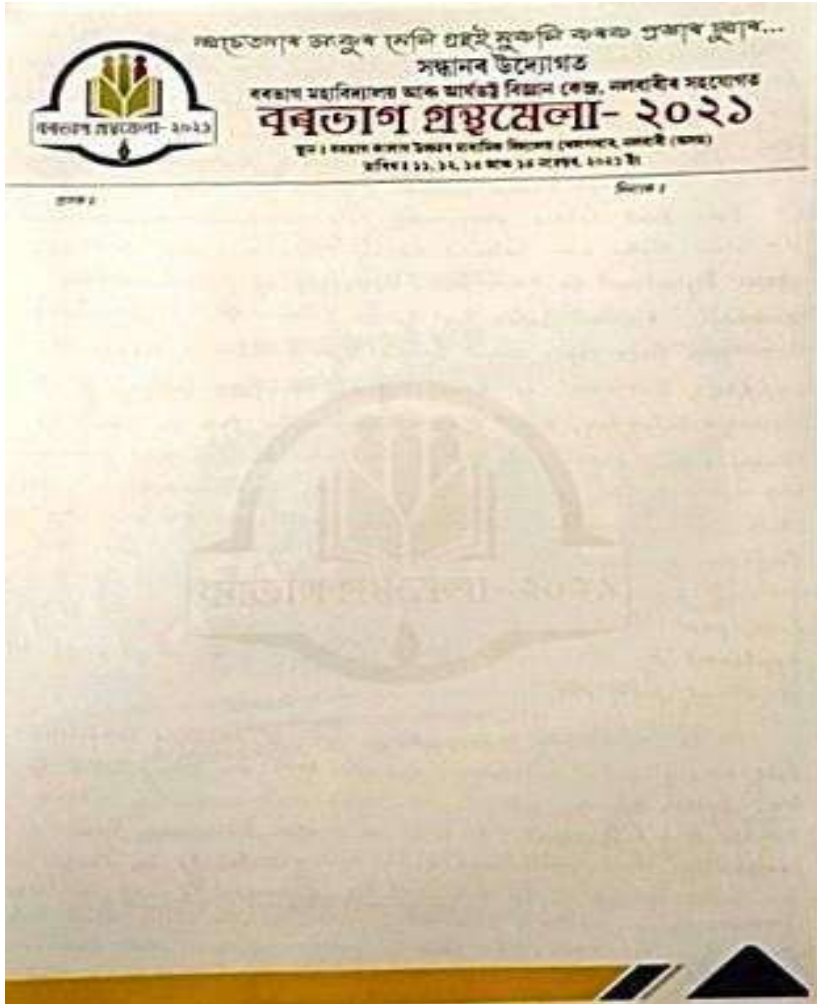

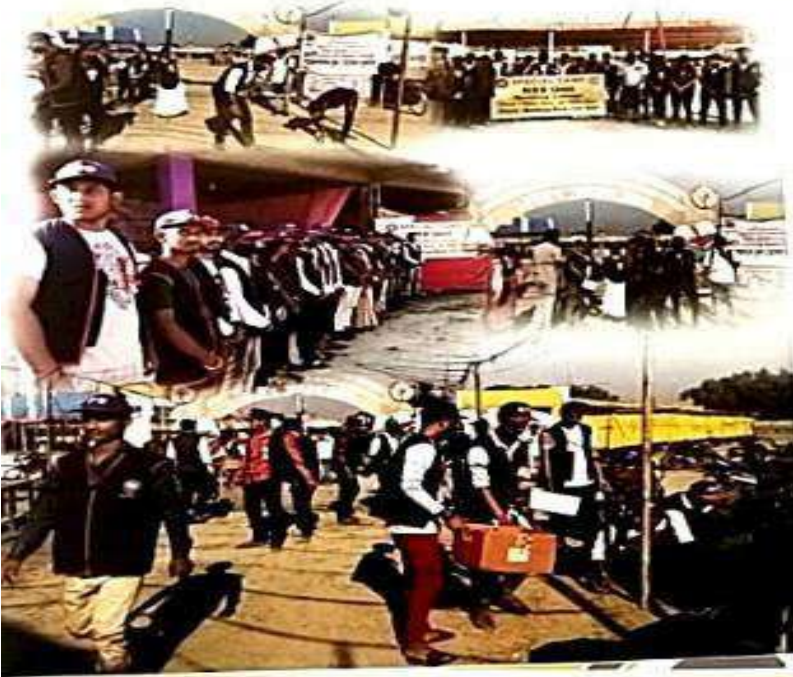

With a view to promoting cooperation and collaboration in matters relating to education, public-health, environment, capacity building, exposure, social mobilization or other issues and mutual benefit, this Memorandum of Understanding is hereby signed between, Barbhag College, Kalag and 6 No. Barbhag Anchalik Panchayat, Kamarkuchi Nalbari, Assam, and hereinafter may be collectively referred to as 'the Parties'. The areas of collaboration, cooperation and association shall include organisation of project works and internship programme for students, health awareness/sensitization programme, environmental awareness programme, capacity building training, exchange of resource persons, student exposure and related other issues. The primary objectives of this MoU are to facilitate students as well as faculty members of the college and NGO stakeholders to experience social work at and such other activities as are feasible

broader platform by sharing knowledge and working together. Further, the MoU will also help the students as well as faculty members of the college and the Panchayat stakeholders through mutual access to resources.

The MoU is signed by **Mrs. Nivedita Goswami**, Principal, i/c, Barbhag College and **Sri Mahendra Nath Sarma**, Chairman, 6 No. Barbhag Anchalik Panchayat.

(a) The MoU will encourage the following cooperative activities, in particular:

1. Policy dialogue to regularly exchange information and experience on mass education as well as social challenges and to identify priorities for bilateral cooperation in the field of health, education, awareness, capacity building and social mobilization.
2. Exchange and professional development of officials, resource persons, experts, students, faculty and Panchayat workers.
3. Organisation of joint awareness/sensitization programme, capacity building training, exhibitions and symposia on matters of mutual interest. Moreover the parties agree to work together for mass-awareness in respect of sensitive social, educational, and economic issues and will take initiatives for transfer of knowledge in different fields.
4. Arrangement of requisite infrastructure for above mentioned activities as per need of the college and the organisation.
5. Arrangement of Student exposure program, student internship program of the college or exposure program of social training groups of the Panchayat whereby both the parties could be benefited by having access to learning resources in each other's institutions.

(b) The cost of cooperative activities may be funded as mutually determined. All cooperative activities under this MoU will be subject to the availability of funds of the college and the Panchayat.

(c) This MoU may be amended by mutual written consent of the college and the NGO.

(d) This MoU will remain in effect for an initial period of 5 (five) years and may be extended, on mutual consent, for successive periods spanning not less than one year.

(d) The MoU may be terminated by mutual agreement of both the college and the Panchayat. However, under no circumstances, termination can take place less than one year after it is signed.

6. Arrangement of requisite infrastructure and other professional activities for faculty members as per need of the institution.
7. Student exchange program, whereby students in both institutions could be benefited by having access to learning resources in each other's institutions.

(b) The cost of cooperative activities may be funded as mutually determined. All cooperative activities under this MoU will be subject to the availability of funds of the institutions.


(c) This MoU may be amended by mutual written consent of the colleges.

(f) The MoU may be terminated by mutual agreement of both institutions. However, under no circumstances, termination can take place less than one year after it is signed.



Whereas

- 1.7. ICT Academy agrees to provide various domain specific training program to the teachers in the university and its colleges on regular basis.
- 1.8. ICT Academy shall bring industry certified trainers of the BARBHAG COLLEGE, NALBARI, ASSAM, on every program conducted for the teachers/researchers of the college.

2. Operation of this MOU

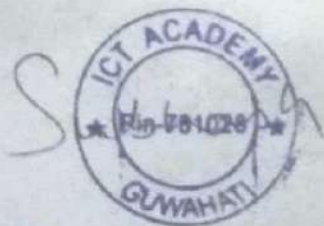

The resource persons of the programme were: Mr. SubhashUpadhyaya (State Head, ICT Academy, North East), Deep SekharSapcota (Relationship Manager, ICT Academy, North East.), Mr. ParthaPratimPathak (Independent SPSS Consultant & Trainer), Dr. Sushanta Kr. Kashyap (Controller of Examinations, Kumar BhaskarVarma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University, Nalbari), Dr. Kaushik Kr. Deka (Associate Professor., Dept. of English, M.N.C. BalikaMahavidyalaya, Nalbari) and Dr. NiharRanjanKalita (Associate Prof., Dept. of Economics, SBMS College Sualkuchi, Kamrup). With each session, there was an interactive session between the resource person and the participants who exchanged their views and answered the questions raised by the participants.

The Faculty Development Programme was started with an inaugural session on 14th February, 2022 at 5 pm onwards through zoom online meeting facility. Dr. Khanikar Mout, Assistant Professor of the Department of Assamese of the Barbhag College was the moderator of the programme. At the beginning of the inaugural session, Dr. Khanikar Mout welcomed all the participants and briefly outlined the purpose behind organizing the programme to all the participants. After this, Dr. AnupamDutta, Coordinator of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (I.Q.A.C.) of Barbhag College provided a short welcome speech to all the participants. Dr.

Duttathen explained the needs of organizing the programme and how this programme would be beneficial for the faculty and the researchers who are carrying research activities in the field of social science and humanities. After the welcome speech of Dr. Anupam Dutta, Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Principal of the Barbhag College started his inaugural speech of the programme. Explaining about the need and significance of research in social science and humanities, Dr. Birinchi Choudhury urged the participants to do systematic and scientific research by availing helps from all the digital tools and to contribute towards the betterment of society. Dr. Choudhury, then inaugurated the programme. The moderator then explained and introduced the topic of the inaugural session. The topic was “Defining a Research Problem” and the speaker of the session was Dr. Kaushik Kr. Deka, Associate Professor of the Dept. of English of M.N.C. Balika Mahavidyalaya of Nalbari district of Assam. Dr. Kaushik Deka stressed on the problems of defining a research problem in social science and humanities in his speech. Both academic disciplines being primarily focused on humans and their societies are very problematic for researchers to fix research problems. The nature of study of social science and humanities are subject to the situation where generalization or formulating theory is not possible due to the unpredictable human behaviours. In both these disciplines, the research problem must survive the relevancy test i.e. the quality of measurement procedure that provides repeatability and accuracy. He defined a good research problem as those having the following qualities like, introduction of the importance of the topic, anchors the research questions, hypotheses or assumptions, place the topic under particular context and provide framework for reporting the result. After his speech, Dr. Deka also participated in an interactive session with the participants where exchange of opinions among the resource person and the participants took place.

On 15th February, 2022 on 5 pm, the second session was organized through virtual mode. Moderator, Dr. Khanikar Mout after welcoming all the participants introduced the topic of discussion in front of the participants. The topic for this session was “Different Methods in Social Science Research”. The resource person of this session was Dr. Nihar Ranjan Kalita, Associate Prof. of the Dept. of Economics of SBMS College, Sualkuchi of Kamrup district. Enlightening the participants with his knowledge on the selected topic for the session, Dr. Kalita used a slight show presentation to explain different methods of research used in Social Science. He identified different stages in sociological research which are vital for systematic study in social science. These stages include (a) choosing a research topic, (b) conducting a literature review, (c) measuring variables and gathering data, (d) analyzing data, and (e) drawing a conclusion. He provided a stage wise description of the research programme and explained the need of every stage. Then Dr. Kalita explained methods like survey method, experiment method, interview method and observation method which are commonly used in social science research. He also talked about the methods of data analysis of the social science research like the qualitative and quantitative methods. At the end of his speech, the resource person called upon the faculty and researchers in the field of social science and humanities to explore different fields

with the help of digital tools available in their hands. In the question and Answer round of the session, the resource persons cleared the doubts and concerns raised by the participants.

The third training session of this faculty development programme was held on 16th February, 2022. “Quantitative and Qualitative Data Analysis” was the topic of the training session. Mr. SubhashUpadhyaya, the State Head of ICT Academy, North East was the resource person of this session. Mr. SubhashUpadyaya talked about the importance of Quantitative and Qualitative Research in social science and humanities. To him, the quantitative method that counts on collecting and analyzing the numerical data can be of great use in social science. He maintained that the quantitative research method has the strength of vital information about the human being and society through survey, examinations, record and censuses which is not possible for individual researcher to collect from simple observation. He identified useful methods in quantitative research, like cross-sectional studies, longitudinal studies, opinion polls, questionnaire, social attitude surveys, surveys which can provide with the necessary data to draw conclusion in sociological studies. Explaining the need of qualitative method in social science and humanities, Mr. Upadhyaya said that it has the benefit of explaining individual by in-depth study of feeling, behavior and relations etc. Participant observation, in-depth study, semi-structured and unstructured interviews, open questionnaire survey and observation are some of the methods used in qualitative study of society which cannot be expressed through numerical presentation of research data. The participants asked many questions in the interactive session and the resource persons responded accordingly.

The fourth session of this programme held on 17th February, 2022 and the topic of this session was “the Use of SPSS in Research”.Mr. ParthaPratimPathak, SPSS Consultant & Trainer was present in the programme as resource person on this session. He put forwarded his view on the use of SPSS, the statistical software platform in the research of social science and humanities. Statistical Package for Social Science, SPSS is designed to enrich the experience of researchers with the help of in-depth analysis of the complex statistical data. He then presented a PPT over the core functioning of SPSS i.e. statistics programmes, modular programmes, text analysis for Surveys Programme and Visualization Designer, which can be successfully deployed in social science and humanities research.

On the 18th February, 2022, the fifth training session of the programme was held. The topic for the session was “Problems of Social Science Research”.Mr. Deep SekharSapcota, Relationship Manager of ICT Academy of the North East was the resource person of the training session. Mr. Sapcota identified different problems which create hindrances in the research activity. The considerable known challenges are development of conceptualizations, problem of maintaining objectivity, difficulty in the verification of the inferences, unpredictability and problem of universalizationetc that can be rarely avoided in social science research.He identified the study of social trends, dynamics and principles that exist between individuals and society as the main concerns of research and these would lead to better understanding of social factors that motivate and influence human behaviours and in the analysis of human interaction. This kind of

systematic and objective analysis would lead to generalization or theories resulting in predication and possibly ultimate control of events in society.

The last training session of the programme was organized on 19th February, 2022. Dr. Sushanta Kr. Kashyap, Controller of Examinations, Kumar BhaskarVarma Sanskrit and Ancient Studies University of Nalbari graced the last and the closing session of this programme. The topic selected for the session was “Publishing / Reporting Research work (Includes Writing Research Report or Thesis)”. Dr. Kashyap, in his speech, identified the criteria of a good research paper or thesis. He also warned the research scholar to be careful in publishing the research work. After the question and answer session, the closing ceremony of the one-week faculty development programme took place. Dr. BirinchiChoudhury, Principal of Barbhag College, put forwarded the closing remarks of the programme. He congratulated the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, ICT Academy, the Resource Persons and the participants of the Programme for successfully completed the programme. After this, Dr. AnupamDutta, Coordinator of IQAC of Barbhag College provided the vote of thanks to all. After this, the moderator announced the closing of the programme.

At the end of the Faculty Development Programme, online certificates were also provided to all the active participants. Thus with the presence of the resource persons and the participants, the programme ended in a positive note.

The programme initially is for five years which plans to provide collaborative co-operation through:

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
- a. Collaborative research in specific fields of interest – KAV and BC will jointly identify specific fields to conduct collaborative research of mutual interest and benefit.

- g. Any other form of co-operation that may be agreed upon between KAV and BC



REPORT

Introduction

A one-day Faculty Development Programme on “NAAC Assessment and Accreditation Process of HEIs” was organised by Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Vishvavidyalaya (KAV), a private university recognised by Govt. of Assam in collaboration with IQAC, Barbhag College, a UGC recognised provincialised college under Govt. A total number of 38 participants, all faculty members of Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Vishvavidyalaya, took active part in the programme. Dr. Anupam Dutta, Associate Prof. and Coordinator, IQAC, Barbhag College and Dr. Kishore Kalita, Librarian, Barbhag College were the resource persons for the programme.

Naugural Session

The inaugural session started at 10.45 a.m. with the formal felicitation of the invited guests and resource persons that include Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Principal, Barbhag College, Dr. Anupam Dutta, Associate Prof. and IQAC Coordinator, Barbhag College and Dr. Kishore Kalita, Librarian, Barbhag College, by the university administration.

The programme was inaugurated by Dr. Kamala Kanta Dutta, Registrar, KAV at 11 a.m. by lighting the ceremonial lamp. Delivering his inaugural speech Dr. Dutta underlined the importance of HEIs to undergo the process of assessment and accreditation by a recognised accrediting agency of higher education. He said that KAV is a relatively new university and is yet to undergo any process of assessment and accreditation by an external agency. It is very important for the university to understand the accreditation process and go for it as early as possible. That will help the university to find the right direction in their effort to ensure quality assurance in the functioning of the university. He thanked the IQAC, Barbhag College for agreeing to their request to apprise the faculty members of the university about the assessment and accreditation process of NAAC. He expressed hope that the programme would help the faculty members who participated in the Faculty Development Programme to understand the quality initiatives that needed to be adopted by the university and would act accordingly in the coming days.

Technical session-I

The first technical session started at 12 p.m.. It was presided over by Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, Principal, Barbhag College. The resource person for the session was Dr. Anupam Dutta, associate Prof. and IQAC Coordinator, Barbhag College. Dr. Dutta gave a structured presentation on the assessment and accreditation process of HEIs by NAAC. In his presentation he nicely put forward the process of how a new HEI can go about the assessment and accreditation process. Right from registering the HEI with NAAC to submission of IIQA, SSR and the process of DVV and Peer Team visit, every detail was explained with appropriate literature and screenshots. He emphasised on the fact that documenting the academic and other related activities is an important exercise for HEIs which wish to go for accreditation process by NAAC. He called upon the faculty members to go through all literature available in NAAC website with regard to quality issues. He also called

upon them to go through the SSR format to have a clear idea of the direction in which the university should work with a view to assuring quality in the institution. Dr. Dutta then explained the SSR formal criterion-wise and Quality Indicator-wise and Matrix-wise. The presentation was followed by a lively interactive session between the resource persons and the participants.

The chair concluded the first technical session with his final remarks on the subject under discussion. He called upon the university administration and the faculty members to work together with Barbhag College for academic development of both the HEIs. The first technical session concluded at 1.30 p.m.

Technical Session-II

The second technical session started at 2.30 p.m. following lunch. The session was presided over by Dr. Kamala Kanta Dutta, Registrar, Krishnaguru Adhyatmik Vishvavidyalaya. The resource person for the session was Dr. Kishore Kalita, Librarian, Barbhag College. In his presentation Dr. Kalita explained to the participants the role of the library in the quality assurance initiatives of HEIs. He said that the library in any HEI is the heart of the institution. So, the library can guide the institution in the academic matters if it functions properly. He explained in detail how the library of an HEI can help in the overall academic progress of the institution. He then gave a well structured presentation on the expectations of NAAC from the library in the assessment and accreditation process.

Dr. Kalita, in his talk, further emphasised the fact that it is important to modernise the library with a view to supporting the students academically. As the library has the responsibility of providing the most important support service to the students, it has to keep itself updated by adopting all contemporary library practices. He said that in this digital era, digitalising the services of the library is essential. Therefore, the university should go for the process of transforming the library from the manual system to the digital system. He called upon the faculty members and the librarian of the university to work consistently towards developing the library, so that it can be one of the most important components in the progress of the university.

The presentation given by Dr. Kishore Kalita was followed by an interactive session. The participants raised a number of queries with regard to the strategies for developing the library and regarding how the library can be modernised within a relatively short time. The resource person responded to the queries to the satisfaction of the participants.

The second technical session concluded with the chair thanking the resource person and the participants for making the session lively and useful. He concluded the session by expressing hope that in the days to come Barbhag College will keep offering their helping hand the efforts of KAV to undergo the assessment and accreditation process by NAAC.

Conclusion

At the end of the programme, certificates of participation were distributed among all the participants. The programme finally concluded with Dr. Mukul Das, a faculty member, proposing vote of thanks to all concerned. The programme came to a conclusion at 4.00 p.m.

4. Arrangement of requisite infrastructure for above mentioned activities as per need of the college and the school.

5. Arrangement of Student exposure trips, student internship program of the college or exposure programs of academic interest whereby both the parties could be benefited by having access to learning resources in each other's institutions.
- (b) 1. The cost of cooperative activities may be funded as mutually determined. All cooperative activities under this MoU will be subject to the availability of funds of the college and the school. However as the school has limited financial resources, the college agrees to provide all expenses for necessary arrangement like venue, participants, resource persons, sound system and refreshment of participants etc. for all the activities to be done at the college venue.

4. The MoU may be terminated by mutual agreement of both the college and the school. However, under no circumstances, termination can take place less than one year after it is signed.



Today, the 7th of April 2022, a daylong training programme on "Learners' Oriented Teaching-Learning" is organized by IQAC, Barbhag College, Kalag, Nalbari, Assam and Sankardev Bidya Niketan, Baharghat, Nalbari, Assam. The programme is part of a joint initiative by the two institutions under the terms of reference as stipulated in the MoU signed by the two institutions. The main objective of the training programme is to train the teachers of the school in learners' oriented teaching methodology, so that, the teachers of the school can be made skillful in planning their lessons by adopting these methods. Mr. Kamal Baruah, one of the resource persons, has started his training session by presenting a well-designed and informative paper on school level teaching methodology. In his presentation he has given importance on learners' active involvement in the teaching-learning process which makes the learners comfortable in class room situation. Mr. Baruah, in his session, has also explained the importance of two-way participation in school level teaching to develop the confidence level of the learners and to make the class-room environment much more interactive. He has explained the benefits of participatory learning for building an interest in the routine classes so that the monotony in teaching-learning process can be lessened.

The second technical session of the training programme is conducted by Mr. Polash Nath. In this session the primary focus has been given to understand the importance of adopting learner's oriented teaching-learning method in respect of teaching the subject of mathematics. Mr. Polash Nath, in his speech has focused on student-centered teaching. He has suggested that student-centered teaching should be the base for teaching mathematics in school education. He is of the opinion that in most of the schools, mathematics is still taught in a traditional way – a teacher stands in front of the class and students repeat formulas from the board. This method is suited for only a small percentage of students when most children find it boring. Mr. Nath opines that unlike in the traditional teaching methods, deeper student participation in the class and implementing math calculations to real life situations should be main aim of a teacher. Students get to be more active while the teacher is mentoring and guiding the class. Mr. Polash Nath also discussed important aspects like * Gaining confidence through inquiry-based learning * Teachers in the position of students etc.

The daylong training programme is concluded with a brief speech by the Pradhan Acharyya of the school Mr. Tilak Talukdar. Through his speech, Mr. Talukdar has expressed his gratitude to the IQAC of Barbhag College for organizing such an informative and practical academic training programme. Dr. Biplab Deka, Associate Professor, Department of Assamese, Barbhag College and Dr. Susanta Kumar Kashyap, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, Barbhag College has participated in the lecture programme as the resource persons/speakers. Both of them, in their respective lectures, have shared their knowledge and experiences on the topic and express their concerns over the future of our planet due to insensible human activities. Md. Dr. Deka summarizes the findings of some most systematic reviews that say that climate change is associated with worse human health.

The second lecture of the programme is delivered by Dr Susanta Kumar Kashyap, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics, Barbhag College. In his speech the chief focus has been given to sensitize the student community about the environment degradation happening around us caused by human activities which is also the chief cause of the fast changing climate. He explains the impacts of climate change that include warming temperatures, changes in rainfall, increases in the frequency or intensity of some extreme weather events, and rising sea levels. These impacts threaten our health by affecting the food we eat, the water we drink, the air we breathe, and the weather we experience.










(f) The MoU may be terminated by mutual agreement of both institutions. However, under no circumstances, termination can take place less than one year after it is signed.



On 28.05.2022, a faculty exchange programme between Barbhag College and Bapujee College is organized at Bapujee College. In the beginning of the programme, Dr. Conseng Barua, Assistant Professor, Department of Philosophy, Bapujee College welcomes the students and faculty of Barbhag College. Dr. Barua introduced Dr. Sushanta Kumar Kashyap, Dr. Namita Devi, Dr. Bipab Deka and Dr. Chandan Kalita of Barbhag College. Dr. Ramesh Das, Principal, Bapujee College delivered inaugural speech and discussed about the importance of faculty exchange programme among the colleges.

Then Dr. Namita Devi, Assistant Professor, Department of History, Barbhag College discussed about the Swadeshi Movement and Trusteeship Principle of Mahatma Gandhi in the context of present scenario. She also mentioned about the Gandhi's idea of decentralized planning and Panchayatiraj system. Then Dr. Sushanta Kumar Kashyap, Assistant Professor, Department of Economics discussed about the interdisciplinary approach of the subject Economics. He mentioned the relationship of Economics with Philosophy and ducation. In his speech he mentioned that Philosophy and Economics studies topics such as public economics, behavioural economics, rationality, justice, history of economic thought, rational choice, the appraisal of economic outcomes, institutions and processes, the status of highly idealized economic models, the ontology of economic phenomena and the possibilities of acquiring knowledge of them. She also stated that it is useful to divide philosophy of economics in this way into three subject matters which can be regarded respectively as branches of action theory, ethics, and philosophy of science. Economic theories of rationality, welfare, and social choice defend substantive philosophical theses often informed by relevant philosophical literature and of evident interest to those interested in action theory, philosophical psychology, and social and political philosophy.

After that Dr. Chandan Kalia discussed about the philosophy of Amartya Sen and his theory of inequality of reexamined. Dr. Kalita in the very beginning stated that Indian Economist Amartya sen was awarded the 1998 Nobel Prize in Economic Sciences for his contributions to welfare economics and social choice theory and for his interest in the problems of society's poorest members. His work on social choice theory is seminal, and his writings on poverty, famine, and development, as well his contributions to moral and political philosophy, are important and influential. Sen's views about the nature and primacy of liberty also make him a

major contemporary liberal thinker. She also stated that Sen's central argument is that resources should not be the exclusive focus of concern for a fairness-based theory of justice, even if, like Rawls's primary goods, they are deliberately chosen for their general usefulness to a good life. Dr. Kalita also discussed about the famous work of Amartya Sen "The Argumentative Indian". Dr. Biplab Deba delivered lecture about the importance of literature in the competitive examinations.

The students of Philosophy, Education and Economics of both the colleges interacted with them and were benefitted from the programme.



Workshop on Traditional Technique of Eco-dyeing Process
Jointly Organised by
Barbhag College and Gramya Vikash Mancha
Under MoU

Venue: Conference Hall, Barbhag College

Date: 15/02/2022

Today, the 15th February, 2022, a one day workshop entitled as “Traditional Technique of Eco-dyeing Process” is organized jointly by Barbhag College and Gramya Bikash Mancha (GVM). The eco-dyeing process is a sustainable and environmentally friendly technique that involves extracting color from natural source. The programme is part of a unique initiative for innovations in the handloom weaving sector by GVM, an international level voluntary organization. The main objective of the programme is to transfer some innovative techniques relating to eco-dyeing of handloom cloth developed by the weavers of Bagurumba Weavers Development Trust” working under guidance and support of Gramya Bikash Mancha. Mr. Diwakar Deka, Secretary, GVM and Ms Padma Boro, a master weaver and a master trainer have participated in the programme as the resource person. At the very beginning, Dr. Birinchi Choudhury, the Principal of Barbhag College, has delivered the welcome address and formally declared the workshop open. In his short speech Dr Choudhury has explained the objectives of organizing the workshop and has also explained the initiative taken by Barbhag College for building an innovative ecosystem.

In the first technical session Mr. Diwakar Deka, has thoroughly explained the initiatives, ideas and technique developed by the weavers working under the ‘Bagurumba Weavers Development Trust’. He has shown a video presenting the technicality of eco-dyeing as been in practice amongst the weavers. He has shown images/ photographs of some of the herbal plants/trees, parts of which are being used in a natural process for dyeing the yarn used in traditional handlooms. He has explained the whole process of eco-dyeing mentioning different plants used for different cloths.

In the second technical session Ms. Padma Boro has demonstrated various traditional cloths that are being naturally dyed. She has explained how the organic colors are produced by using natural sources such as leaves, roots, flowers and barks and how the yarn is dyed with these colors. She has demonstrated how a particular color is produced by mixing certain herbal mixture and the resultant dyed cloth pieces. Then an interactive session is being conducted and the queries of the students are being answered by Ms. Padma Boro. Dr. Dhaneshwar Baishya, Dr. Susanta Kumar Kashyap, or Biplab deka and Dr. Chandan Kalita, all members of faculty of different departments have also shared their knowledge relating to the importance and prospects of organically dyed clothing’s. The programme finally concluded at about 3.30 P.M. with vote of thanks being delivered by Dr. Chandan Kalita, faculty member department of English. Altogether 51 participants attended the workshop.

**Exposure field visit to Bagurumba Weaver's
Development Trust Organised under the Initiative of Barbhag
College and Gramya Vikash Mancha
Place: Training Center, Bagurumba Weaver's Development
Trust, Chatra, Nalbari
Date: 07/04/23**

Today, on 07/04/23, a team consisting of 8 teachers and 10 students of Barbhag College has paid a visit to training center of Bagurumba Weaver's Development Trust situated at Chatra in the district of Nalbari. The field visit is conducted to obtain first hand and practical knowledge of the eco-dyeing process of local variety of yarn, which are being used to weave some local varieties of cloths with the organically produced colors. The team under the leadership of Dr. Sushanta Kumar Kashyap has arrived at the centre at about 11.30 AM. It is really inspiring to see the internal discipline of the center which is working both as a production unit and as a training centre. There is a well conducted to explain the students about the nature and objectives of the field study. Ms Padma Boro, the master weaver, has given an introduction explaining the functioning of the center. Dr. Nandita Goswami, Dr Namita Devi and Dr. Chandan Kalita, all faculty members of Barbhag College, have delivered motivational speeches targeting students.

At about 12.45pm, the students being guided to the production centre, where the weavers are seen busy with weaving activities. The students with the help of a standard questionnaire have collected some data from the weavers. Some of the innovative practices for eco-dyeing are being displayed to the students. Then the team is being taken to the show-room attached to the centre where some finished products are displayed for the trainee as well as for other visitors. Ms. Padma Boro and her co-workers have explained to the students how these clothes are being dyed with organic colors. At about 2.30 pm the team returned to the college premises with a sense of satisfaction being enriched with some fresh knowledge.
